


MARINA BAY SANDS SETS THE SCENE FOR THIRD EDITION OF 'WHERE ART TAKES SHAPE'


backgrounds to appreciate art as a universal language that transcends cultures and generations," said Mr Paul Town, Chief Operating Officer at Marina Bay Sands.

At the heart of the festival is ART SG, the leading international art fair in Singapore and Southeast Asia. Taking place from 17 to 19 January 2025, the art fair has firmly established its position as a world-class event, bringing together 106 outstanding galleries from 30 countries at Sands Expo & Convention Centre.

Attendees can look forward to a selection of contemporary art, thought-provoking talks and an engaging film programme in collaboration with ArtScience Museum, which presents an innovative selection of film and video works created by artists, juxtaposed with films about the lives and careers of well-known artists. On the eve of ART SG's official opening, ticket holders to the exclusive Vernissage will be among the first to preview art pieces from some of the world's most renowned galleries. The exploration of transformative cultural narratives in art continues with *Behind the Canvas Series 1: Jean-Michel Basquiat* at Sands Expo & Convention Centre. Happening from 16 December 2024 to 6 March 2025, the immersive experience offers a deeper look into Basquiat's creative journey, showcasing his compelling sketches, illustrations and his innovative integration of art, fashion, literature and technology as he emerged as a revolutionary figure in contemporary art. During the festival, ArtScience Museum also welcomes visitors to explore and gain new perspectives on art through two large-scale, immersive exhibitions. <u>The World of Studio Ghibli</u>, which made its debut as Singapore's first official Studio Ghibli exhibition in October 2024, offers a captivating journey through 16 theatrical sets inspired by the studio's iconic animation films across 11 galleries.

At the same time, <u>Altered States: Experiments in Moving Image</u> pushes the boundaries of moving image through four striking film presentations, complemented by a documentation of iconic figures in analogue and direct filmmaking. Originally planned as a month-long exhibition, <u>Altered States</u> has been extended to 2 February 2025 due to popular demand, allowing art enthusiasts and the wider community to delve into the timeless allure of analogue films and experimental techniques.



Be part of a culinary celebration that bridges art and cuisine

Art takes a sensory turn at *Culinary Curations*, where Marina Bay Sands' chefs craft exquisite dishes and limited-time tipples inspired by the festival's vibrant key visuals. Throughout the festival, renowned restaurants such as Maison Boulud and WAKUDA Restaurant & Bar will also offer exclusive Show & Dine bundles, featuring specially curated dining experiences that blend artistry and gastronomy.

In a creative nod to the green hues of fresh kiwi, Yardbird's Abegaile Sanchez presents 'Kiwi & Canvas Cocktail', a bourbon-based cocktail that captures the vitality and precision of art. At Maison Boulud, Chef Mandy Pan pays homage to Singapore with the 'Floating Island' dessert, featuring blue pea flowers that are also used in the restaurant's cocktail Butterfly Kiss.
