

MARINA BAY SANDS REIMAGINES THE SKYPARK OBSERVATION DECK WITH A NEW ELEVATED EXPERIENCE

The newly revamped attraction takes visitors on a journey that explores the past, present and future of Marina Bay

Singapore (15 January 2025) — Marina Bay Sands invites visitors to trace Singapore's evolution from the 1800s to present day at the newly-upgraded SkyPark Observation Deck. Featuring a new showcase titled *Skyline Singapore: Stories from Above*, the popular public attraction tells the story of the transformation of Marina Bay, including the pivotal opening of Marina Bay Sands in 2010, into a multi-faceted city space that comprises a financial hub, civic district and expansive recreation area.

Opening on 17 January, the showcase unfolds across the ticketing counters at Basement 1 of Marina Bay Sands Hotel Tower 3 to the sweeping views of the SkyPark Observation Deck 56 storeys above. It presents a narrative that charts Marina Bay from its origins as a historic waterfront to becoming an iconic part of Singapore's shimmering skyline.

"With Skyline Singapore: Stories from Above, the SkyPark Observation Deck evolves from a vantage point for admiring views to a journey through the history, innovation and



inspiration behind Marina Bay, including how Marina Bay Sands was built. This new showcase reveals how Marina Bay has transformed into a globally significant destination for both local and international visitors, while celebrating the spirit of Singapore. SkyPark Observation Deck invites visitors to experience not only the transformation of Marina Bay, but to also explore the diversity, culture and neighbourhoods that make Singapore so unique. It's a chance for visitors to connect with the country in new ways, and for locals to rediscover just what's so special about the place we all call home," said Honor Harger, Vice President of Attractions at Marina Bay Sands.

Skyline Singapore: Stories from Above begins at Basement 1, where visitors are invited to explore Marina Bay's past, from its historical role as a trading port to its evolution as a bustling commercial centre to its transformation into a world-class waterfront destination.

Through a compelling blend of historical photographs and informative interpretation, visitors will gain a deeper understanding of the vision, innovation and determination of Singapore's leaders who played a pivotal role in the development of Marina Bay.

The showcase continues at Level 56 of SkyPark Observation Deck with a celebration of Singapore. Visitors will be greeted with a striking LED wall depicting iconic landmarks, as



well as Singapore's diverse neighbourhoods such as Kampong Glam, Chinatown and Joo Chiat. These sights and cultural districts are further introduced in a series of new interpretative panels on the balustrades of the Observation Deck at Levels 56 and 57.

Prominent buildings which can be seen from the deck, such as Gardens by the Bay, the Singapore Flyer, Esplanade and Marina Barrage, are introduced, as are the heartlands that lie behind the immediate surroundings of Marina Bay including Little India, East Coast and even St John's Island.

Following their enlightening visit to the Observation Deck, visitors can make their way back to the Level 56 lobby to engage with an interactive world map, which encourages them to mark their place of origin. They are also invited to envision the future of Marina Bay by voting on their favourite Al-generated concept for the Bay.

As visitors return to Basement 1, the showcase bids them farewell with a vision of Marina Bay Sands' future and encourages them to explore Singapore's rich diversity by visiting some of the landmarks they observed from the deck above. A map featuring landmarks with accompanying QR codes invites further exploration.

"The revamped SkyPark Observation Deck is a celebration of Marina Bay's extraordinary history. It brings together historical narratives and new perspectives on the present and the future, offering visitors an invitation to see Singapore from a fresh viewpoint. It transforms the SkyPark Observation Deck from merely a vantage point into a place of storytelling, where Singapore's past meets a vision for the future," added Ms Harger.
