Singapore (21 January 2025) – Marina Bay Sands is set to welcome the Year of the Snake in spectacular fashion from 27 January, lighting up the property with its annual Chinese New Year extravaganza and special retail experiences.

Meanwhile, the contemporary and artistic decorations in the auspicious hue of Singapura Red, one of Marina Bay Sands' unique accent colours, extend throughout the property as a symbol of good fortune and prosperity. Inspired by classic Chinese paintings, these installations depict an evoking tale of snakes gliding upwards through mountainous landscapes to form different characters such as 福 (*Fu, Fortune*), 春 (*Chun, Spring*), 吉 (*Ji, Luck*) and 发 (*Fa, Prosperity*), leaving behind red blessings that adorn its surroundings. These blessings will be displayed prominently across the integrated resort at various locations, including the Hotel Tower 1 lobby and The Shoppes' Grand Colonnade between Gucci and CHANEL.

At The Shoppes, zodiac boards designed as captivating scrolls will elegantly flank the snake installation, inviting visitors to discover their fortunes for the year ahead and capture a mesmerising photo moment.
