***Sands Live Season* concert series returns this December with a star-studded lineup**

*From December to March, the integrated resort will
present a series of seven concerts with Asian
powerhouses taking centre-stage*



Singapore (21 October 2024) – Marina Bay Sands’ premier live concert series ***Sands Live Season*** will make a roaring return this December with a powerhouse line-up of renowned music artistes from China, Taiwan, Malaysia and Singapore, staging seven concerts over a span of four months.

This upcoming season of show-stopping concerts will include performances by popular mandopop artistes Jane Zhang, Firdhaus, Leah Dou and A-Lin, Cantopop sensations Twins and Liza Wang, and local music legends Lee Weisong and Lee Sisong.

The season will kick off on 21 December with Chinese singer-songwriter and vocal powerhouse ***Jane Zhang***. The pop diva will make her performance debut at Marina Bay Sands as part of her “LIGHT World Tour”, which will see Zhang performing in Sydney, Auckland and multiple cities across China. Since her debut in 2005, Zhang has solidified her status as a global music icon, and made appearances at global events such as the Grammy Awards and Victoria’s Secret Fashion Show. With seven Chinese albums, nearly 300 singles and

numerous prestigious awards under her belt, Zhang's formidable discography and vast global fanbase are testament to her exceptional musical prowess.

Hot on the heels of Zhang's performance, Cantopop duo Charlene Choi and Gillian Chung, better known as **Twins**, will light up the stage on 28 and 29 December with their pop hits. The Hong Kong duo, who need no introduction in the Chinese music industry, have carved an illustrious career in music since debuting in 2001, chalking up 12 Cantonese and four Mandarin albums. Off stage, the multi-talented performers have also starred in many productions on the silver screen, including Chinese blockbuster movies and television series, such as the award-winning *New Police Story* and romantic comedy film *Love on the Rocks*.

Two of Singapore's most prolific songwriters and producers, **Lee Weisong** and **Lee Sisong**, will be gracing the stage at Sands Grand Ballroom on 31 December to hold a concert in celebration of the 40th anniversary of their storied careers, alongside Singapore's top musical talents. The twin brothers are regarded as two of the most highly acclaimed musicians in Singapore and have written hit songs for big names such as Jacky Cheung, including "A Thousand Reasons To Be Sad," as well as Sandy Lam, with the well-known hit "I Heard That Love Had Returned." Additionally, the duo has mentored and collaborated closely with Stefanie Sun, creating numerous classic songs throughout her career, including "The Dark Day," and "Against the Light", while their work with Gigi Leung has produced catchy tunes like "Chicken Chic" and "Fresh". Titled "Forty For You: Weisong & Sisong - A 40-Year Musical Journey Concert", the performance will ensure a night of celebrations for fans of the Lee brothers and Mandarin pop music enthusiasts. As Marina Bay Sands ushers in the new year, the integrated resort will also be welcoming a rising star in the Mandopop scene, Malaysian singer-songwriter **Firdhaus**, who will be staging a two-night show at Sands Grand Ballroom on 3 and 4 January. Making his musical debut two years ago, **Firdhaus** was quickly catapulted into stardom, and has released multiple wildly popular hits such as "Eternal Friendship", "Up & Down" and "Gulf of Alaska", which have taken top spot on YouTube Music and Spotify's Trending charts, each song amassing over a billion streams online. His euphonious vocals and soulful ballads have promptly earned him a notable name in the Mandopop scene and placed him on the global map. Firdhaus' concert here is part of his "Hello Again" Asia Tour, promising two nights of raw talent and emotional performances.

Prominent Chinese singer-songwriter **Leah Dou** is next in the line-up of artistes to grace the stage at Marina Bay Sands. The 27-year old broke into the music industry in 2016 with the release of her first album *Stone Cafe*, which swiftly led to her nomination for Best Original Film Song at the 53rd Golden Horse Awards in the same year. Despite growing up in the spotlight alongside her parents, Dou managed to carve out her own identity through her music, which features tracks such as "(It's Not a Crime) It's Just What We Do", "My Days" and "River Run", and is known for her unique sound that blends the genres of trip-hop, jazz and R&B. Fans can look forward to her brand of soulful pop when she performs at Sands Theatre on 18 January.

The season continues in March with bona fide Cantopop veteran, **Liza Wang**, performing at Sands Grand Ballroom on 22 and 23 March. Hailed as one of Hong Kong’s pioneering artists, Wang has stood at the forefront of the entertainment industry for close to six decades, and is best known for her outstanding achievements in music, television, film and Cantonese opera. She has played a significant role in shaping the Hong Kong entertainment scene, having won countless prestigious awards across the decades for her work in the industry, including multiple wins for Best Actress and Best Host at major award ceremonies. During her concert here, Wang will showcase familiar classics that are sure to evoke nostalgia and bring back memories of her illustrious career. Rounding off the season is none other than Taiwanese pop icon **A-Lin**, who will also be making her performance debut at Marina Bay Sands on 28 and 29 March. The powerhouse vocalist, known for her string of emotive Mandopop ballads, will present a resplendent repertoire of fan-favourite tracks spanning over two decades. *A-Lin* had a meteoric rise to fame following her debut in 2006 and gained global recognition for her undeniable talent after releasing a slew of singles that showcased her exceptional vocal dexterity, earning her the epithet “A Born Diva”. As one of the most influential singers in the industry, *A-Lin* is best known for her hit singles “Give Me a Reason to Forget”, “Best Friend”, and “A Kind of Sorrow”, and was most recently crowned Best Mandarin Singer at the 34th Golden Melody Awards in 2023.

First unveiled in 2014, **Sands Live** began as a series of up close and intimate concerts that have attracted globally acclaimed performers such as The Rolling Stones, Michael Bublé, Aaron Kwok and Celine Dion. As part of an expanded initiative to bring in top entertainment acts to showcase the biggest stars from Asia and beyond, the integrated resort introduced **Sands Live Season** in 2023, which saw a series of sold-out concerts by the likes of Hong Kong legend George Lam, Cantopop stars Joey Yung and Leo Ku, as well as South Korean pop stars PSY and RAIN, to name a few.
